WEEK 2: CHARACTER DRILL ON TEAMWORK

AGE-SPECIFIC CHARACTER DRILL FOR AGES 13 to 16

DRILL: SPELL A WORD

"When you have teamwork, you can problem-solve well with others. In this drill you are going to put your teamwork skills to the test by spelling out a word using only your bodies."

Steps:

1. Divide your students into several even groups with no less than 3 to a group.
2. When you say "go" each group will collaborate to spell a word with their bodies.
3. Each team only has 2-minutes to spell a word. When the team has a word spelled out with their bodies, then they will raise their hands and the instructor will say "freeze." Every team must freeze exactly where they are until the instructor checks to see if the first team correctly spelled a word with proper letters using only their bodies.
4. If so, then that team wins. If not, then they are disqualified, and the rest of the teams continue until they finish.
5. The first team to spell a word is the winner.
6. You can repeat this drill several times if time permits.
