## WEEK 2: CHARACTER DRILL ON CHARISMA

### AGE-SPECIFIC MAT CHAT FOR AGES 3 & 6

#### **DRILL: POLITE GREETING**

“When you meet others, it is important that you know how to give a polite greeting. A polite greeting is how you introduce yourself. If you are polite when you meet others, it makes them feel good about themselves. That is having good charisma.”

#### **Steps:**

Begin by demonstrating the proper way to give a polite greeting:

- Look the other person in the eyes.
- Smile big!
- Shake their hand with a good grip.
- Say “Hi, my name is \_\_\_\_\_. What’s your name?”
- Finish by saying: “Nice to meet you \_\_\_\_\_.”

Have each student take turns practicing the polite greeting steps by pretending they are meeting you for the first time.

After each student has had a turn practicing the polite greeting with you, have them take turns practicing the polite greeting with one of their classmates.

Finish by having each student practice the polite greeting with a parent.

Make sure you applaud each student as they practice their polite greeting to boost their confidence.
