WEEK 2: CHARACTER DRILL

AGE-SPECIFIC CHARACTER DRILL FOR ALL AGES

DRILL: T-R-U-S-T

“Let’s celebrate one of the most important words in the dictionary, and a word that goes with trustworthy; TRUST. Today we are going to play a game in which we will learn all about being trustworthy and in the process we must collect all of the letters that spell trust.”

Steps:

- Split the class into groups with no more than four to a group for 5 and under and no more than six per group for 8 and up.
- Using index cards, spell out the word t-r-u-s-t and o-u-t by writing one letter on each card. Make a stack for the cards that spell ‘trust’ and make a separate stack for the cards that spell “out”. Make sure you have one set per group.
- To begin, use the attached age specific game sheets to quiz each student about trustworthiness.
- If they answer the question correctly, then they will earn an index card from the t-r-u-s-t stack. If they answer incorrectly, then they will get a card from the o-u-t stack.
- The goal is for the group to spell out the word ‘trust’ before they spell the word ‘out’.
- If they spell ‘trust’ first, they win!
