WEEK 3 PROJECT: TRUSTWORTHY ART

THIS PROJECT IS FOR ALL AGES

"The best way to become more trustworthy is to recognize people that are trustworthy. Those are people that you want to be like. In this project, you are going to draw a picture of people that you think are trustworthy to honor how great they are."

Steps:

- Give each student a blank piece of paper.
- Split the class into several groups and give each group a pack of crayons or markers.
- For the younger kids, assign each group with a teenager or adult that can help with spelling and drawing, or they can have their parents help with this project.
- The students will draw a picture of the following three people:
 - A teacher that you trust
 - A friend that you trust
 - A family member that you trust
- They will decorate the art and then take it home to hang on their bedroom mirror for the entire month to remind them about being trustworthy.

This project is meant to teach your students about being trustworthy. The idea is for each student to recognize people that are trustworthy. With your support, each child should feel motivated to act just like their trustworthy role models.
