BLUE BELT PHYSICAL TESTING REQUIREMENTS (For Students testing for Cho Dan Bo)

Warm Up -

100 Push Ups, 100 Jumping Jacks, 100 Sit Ups, 150 Punches, Stretch Kicks (Poto Oly Ki)

Basic Stances (Called in Korean) -

Cha Ryut (Attention)
Choon Bee Ja Seh (Ready Stance)
Chun Kul Ja Seh (Front Stance)
Hu Kul Ja Seh (Fighting Stance)
Kee Ma Ja Seh (Horse Riding Stance)
Kyo Cha Rip Ja Seh (Cross Leg Stance)

Sa Ko Rip Ja Seh (Side Stance)

Hand Techniques (Called in Korean) –

(Should be able to perform forward or backward)

Ha Dan Mahk Ki (Low block)
Sang Dan Mahk Ki (High block)

Kwon Do (Hammer Fist)
Kwan Soo Kong Kyuck (Spear hand)

Hu Gul Ssang Soo Mahk Ki (Reinforced block – fighting stance)
Chun Gul Ssang Soo Mahk Ki (Reinforced block – front stance)

Soo Do Kong Kyuck (Chop/knife hand attack)

Kap Kwon (Back Fist)

Jang Kwon(Palm heel strike)Ssang Soo Ha Dan Mahk Ki(Low x-block)Ssang Soo Sang Dan Mahk Ki(High x-block)

Yuk Jin (Knife hand block & closet punch in fighting stance)
Yuk Soo (Knife hand block fighting stance, punch in front stance)

Choi Ha Dan Soo Do Mahk Ki (Lowest Knife Hand Block)

Yuk Soo Do Kong Kyuck (Ridge hand strike)

Combination Techniques (Called in English)

Advanced Combinations of Hand/Kick Techniques

Jump Kicking Drill

60 Seconds free form jump kicking against a pad. Use both feet. Get in the air.

Power Kicking -

Each kick will be done 5 times with each leg to measure power and muscular endurance.

Ahp Cha Ki (Front kick)
 Yup Cha Ki (Side Kick)

Tollyo Cha Ki
 Dwi Tollyo Cha Ki
 Deah Ahp Cha Ki
 Deah Yup Cha Ki
 (Roundhouse kick)
 (Spinning Back Kick)
 (Jump front kick)
 (Jump side kick)

Deah Tollyo Cha Ki
 Deah Dwi Cha Ki
 (Jump roundhouse kick)
 (Jump spinning back kick)



Austin Karate Academy Testing Requirements

Rolls & Break Falls -

- 1. Forward Roll (both shoulders)
- 2. Backward Roll (both shoulders)
- 3. Front Break Fall
- 4. Back Break Fall
- 5. Side Break Falls (both shoulders)
- 6. Forward Roll, Backward Roll, Front Break Fall
- 7. Forward Roll into a Break Fall

Forms -

- 1. Sae Kye Hyung IL Bu
- 2. Sae Kye Hyung E Bu
- 3. Sae Kye Hyung Sam Bu
- 4. Pyung Ahn Cho Dan
- 5. Pyung Ahn E Dan
- 6. Pyung Ahn Sam Dan
- 7. Pyung Ahn Sa Dan
- 8. Bong Hyung Il Bu
- 9. Pyung Ahn O Dan
- 10. Bassai
- 11. Naihanchi Cho Dan
- 12. Bong Hyung E Bu

One Steps -

- 1. Hands 1-20 (New 19-20)
- 2. Feet 1-20 (New 19-20)
- 3. Self Defense (Ho Sin Sul) 1-20 (New 19-20)

Free Sparring (Dae Ryun) -

- 1. Each candidate will spar two times 1 min each round
- 2. Two-on-One Sparring one time 30 seconds defending

Breaking (Kyuck Pa) -

The following dimensions are to be used for the wood:

- Ages 12 & under: 1 x 12 x 6 inches
- Ages 13 16: 1 x 12 x 8 inches
- Ages 17 and above: 1 x 12 x **10 inches**

Power Hand Break – 1 board (2 boards for Age 17+)

Power Kick Break - 2 boards

Combination Break – 3 boards combination (one kick, one jump kick and one hand)

Speed Break – 1 board any hand or kick technique for 17+ candidates
