40 Acts of Kindness

Examples: Clean your brother's or sister's room. Clean up the yard without being asked. Say something nice about a family member. Invite someone to be part of a game. Share.

40 Acts of Discipline

Examples: Exerting self-control over your actions and behavior. Doing chores without prompting. Eating healthy. Making positive choices about what you eat (fruits, veggies, water vs. soda, candy, deserts). Following house rules without reminders. Turn off TV and do a sport or activity.
