



With holding in-door, in-person classes, it is our responsibility to keep our students, families, instructors and staff as safe as possible. Listed below are our current protocols.

As always, we appreciate everyone's patience and flexibility as we navigate through this challenging time. We will continue to stay up-to-date and monitor the current situation to adjust protocols, restrictions, and schedules as mandates change and evolve. We greatly appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we do our best to prioritize everyone's safety.

### Current Protocols for Risk Mitigation

- Masks are required for anyone entering the school.
- Masks are required for students participating in In-Person Classes.
- The Lobby will be closed for viewing.
- We will meet or exceed social distance requirements of 6 feet between students for training.
- We will follow social distancing guidelines when allowing students to enter the school and when dismissing students from class.
- We are limiting the number of students allowed in each class.
- Each student will have their own training space/bag.
- Students will be required to use the provided hand sanitizer prior to entering the workout floor.
- Students must show up to class already wearing their uniform/ATA t-shirt/belt.
- Students may bring a water bottle they can keep in their bag, the use of the water fountain is not permitted.
- Parents and students waiting outside for class must adhere to 6 feet social distancing guidelines – orange dots will be placed on the sidewalk 6 feet apart.
- We have scheduled 15 minutes between each class to sanitize the floor and all equipment.
- Parents and students are asked to wait outside/in your car until cleaning procedures are completed in between each class.
