



Allstar Martial Arts Academy Camp Behavior Agreement

All parents/guardians & campers must review and sign this form prior to attending Allstar Camp.

No exceptions.

Camp participants are expected to always exhibit appropriate behavior while at camp. To provide all campers and staff with a camp experience that is safe and enjoyable, the following guidelines have been developed. A caring and positive approach will be taken regarding discipline. Camp staff will reinforce appropriate behavior through positive reinforcement, firm statements, and redirection of activity. All campers must understand and follow the guidelines set forth. Please review this policy and guidelines with your child as violations will result in disciplinary action:

- Talk in a pleasant manner. Foul/Inappropriate language, putdowns, and bullying will not be accepted.
- Be safe! Always obey camp rules and staff. Disruptive behavior will not be accepted.
- Treat all peers, equipment, and the studio with proper care and respect.
- Show respect for the staff and fellow campers.
- Aggressive behavior that is threatening to any child or staff will not be permitted at camp and will result in immediate removal without a refund.
- Have a positive attitude and have fun!

Listed below are the discipline procedures for campers who are exhibiting unacceptable behavior. Depending on the severity of the behavior, we may skip a particular step. (I.e. aggressive behavior will not be tolerated and will result in the immediate removal of a child from camp without a refund.)

1. **Verbal Warning**
2. **Time Out** or time away from the group. During a time out a camper may have to sit out from activities including games, physical activities, board breaking or another special event. Parents will be notified of their child's time out via email.
3. **Written Warning** given to Parent if a child persists in unacceptable behavior, a written warning will be issued. The Lead Counselor will speak with the child immediately during/after the incident and then the parent/guardian upon arrival. The parent/guardian will be required to sign the written warning.

*****After receiving two written warnings the child will be dropped from Summer Camp and will not be permitted to sign up for Summer Day Camp in the future. No refunds will be given.** Please review these rules with your child prior to the first day of camp and return your agreement to the studio prior to attending. Your agreement is mandatory prior to participation. The staff will review these rules with your child at the beginning of each week as well. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. We hope to have a great summer!
